PASSOVER SEDER MEAL!

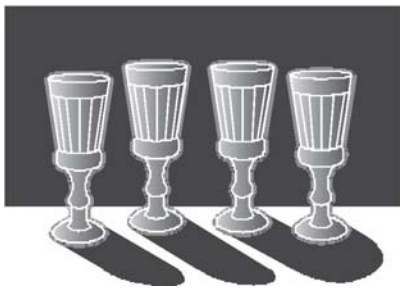
Why is this night different from all others?

Beth Shechinah invites you to join us for our annual Passover Seder Meal. This is our biggest event of the year and we encourage you to join us an exciting evening of inspiration, illumination, special music, messianic dance, along with great food and fellowship!



Passover is the oldest Festival celebrated in the world today, commemorating God's deliverance of the Jewish people from Egyptian bondage 3,500 years ago. Passover, a seven day feast, begins on the 14th of Nisan corresponding to March 29th this year.

It is one of the most significant of the seven Biblical Feasts and is recognized

as 'the beginning of months'. Passover, the first of God's appointed times, represents Israel's birth as an ancient nation and the anniversary of our freedom from Egyptian bondage after 400 years of slavery.

Sh'mot (Exodus) 12:1 - "This month shall be your beginning of months. It shall be the first month of the year to you."

On the first and second nights of Passover, we observe a special time called a Seder during which time the Haggadah is read.

We partake in ceremonial foods reminding us of this ancient Passover story and then share a delicious festive Passover meal together. As Messianic Believers, we also recognize how the first Passover foreshadowed and pointed ahead 2,000 years to the Messiah's Passover when He came to bring the complete meaning of this Feast into fulfillment.

It was during Passover that Yeshua Ha Mashiach offered Himself as the innocent Passover Lamb to take away the sins of the world! "When I see the blood I will pass over you."

As we gather together to observe both of these historic and prophetic events, the apostle Shaul (Paul) said that as we prepare ourselves to observe this feast we are to:

"Purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Messiah our Passover was sacrificed for us. Therefore let us keep this feast not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth." 1 Corinthians 5:7,8

Tradition teaches that in each generation, we must consider ourselves as having personally been freed from the slavery of Egypt. Join us for the evening and be reminded of the anniversary of your freedom as a child of God!
