PROPHETIC SEASON FOR ISRAEL AND THE NATIONS

This fall is shaping up to be a very prophetic season on the calendar for Israel and the nations. This past year has been unprecedented in the Middle East as the world has witnessed civil unrest and war in many Middle East countries. The entire region is very unstable and like a furnace - is ready to explode at any time.

Many radical Islamic factions are vying for power - which will change the landscape of the Middle East

September 2011 will prove to be a pivotal month for Israel. The Palestinians have stated their intentions to forego the peace process with Israel and make a unilateral decision to declare statehood in September.

From September 13 to 28th the U.N. will be gathering together in New York for their General Assembly. Part of their agenda will include a vote to declare a Palestinian state within the borders of Israel. How ironic that the Palestinians want the world to recognize them as a Palestinian state and yet they refuse to recognize Israel, who was voted in by the U.N. 63 years ago, as a sovereign nation.

We are witnessing more and more evidence of the last days. Most world leaders favour dividing Jerusalem and pressuring Israel to divide their land. Israel is told to make peace by the U.S., E.U. and the U.N. or things will get worse. There is an international attempt to delegitimize Israel. "Why do the nations rage and the people plot a vain thing? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the Lord and against His anointed saying, let us break their bonds in pieces and cast away their cords from us. He who sits in the heavens shall laugh." Psalm 2:1-4

It is no coincidence that this vote will be taken just days before Rosh Hashanah, the beginning of God's appointed times. The sound of the Shofar is a warning and a wake-up call for the nations of the soon coming of the Messiah. "Blow the Shofar in Zion and sound an alarm in my holy mountain! Let all the inhabitants of the world tremble. For the day of the Lord is coming, for it is at hand; A day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness..."

The Fall Feasts are an exciting yearly rehearsal on God's Prophetic calendar representing events yet to be fulfilled most notably the return of our Messiah.

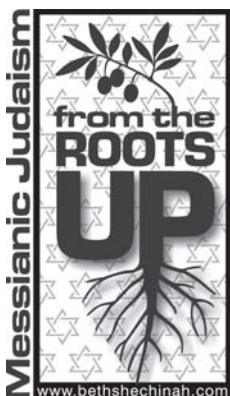
With one hundred blasts on the Shofar the Feast of Trumpets (Rosh Hashanah) begins the cycle of the Fall Feasts. The blowing of the Shofar called Yom Teruah is a worldwide call to repentance, a call to return to the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

Rosh Hashanah introduces the holiest time on the Jewish calendar known as the "Ten Days of Awe", ending on Yom Kippur [Day of Atonement]. Five days later the joyous feast of Sukkot [Tabernacles] will be celebrated.

As Messianic Believers, we view the fall feasts as a time of spiritual renewal and refreshing. They are God's Appointed Times for us to return to our first love, and rekindle our love for Him and rededicate our hearts anew.

The Ten Days of Awe are intended to be a call to begin a process of personal teshuvah, or repentance. These are days to restore our relationships with one another by going to those we may have offended and seek forgiveness and reconciliation. During this season make every effort to reach out and seek to restore broken and hurting relationships that you may be experiencing.
