Beth Shechinah invites you to join us for our exciting annual Passover Seder Meal. Come and hear this ancient story of Passover retold as we partake together in this festive and prophetic event. This year we will be reading from a new Haggadah published by Beth Shechinah. Experience an inspirational evening filled with an atmosphere of dynamic worship and praise, Messianic Dance, multimedia presentations, delicious food and great fellowship!

Passover is the oldest festival celebrated in the world today, commemorating God's deliverance of the Jewish people from Egyptian bondage 3,500 years ago. Passover, an eight day feast, begins on the 14th of Nisan corresponding to April 10th this year.



It is the most significant of the seven Biblical Feasts and is recognized as the beginning of months. Passover, the first of God's appointed times, represents Israel's birth as an ancient nation and the anniversary of our freedom from Egyptian bondage after 400 years of slavery.

Exodus 12:1 – "This month shall be your beginning of months. It shall be the first month of the year to you."

As a Messianic Community we believe Israel's Passover foreshadowed and pointed ahead 2,000 years to the time when the Messiah would come and bring the total and complete meaning of this feast to fulfillment.

This year of 2017 is a unique year. It corresponds to the year 5777 on the Jewish calendar. During our Passover Seder we will be focusing on the prophetic significance of Jerusalem, the City of Destiny as she celebrates her Jubilee this year.

On June 7, 1967, during the Six-Day War, IDF paratroopers advanced through the Old City toward the Temple Mount and the Western Wall bringing Jerusalem's holiest site under Jewish control for the first time in 2,000 years. Jerusalem, the city of controversy and a cup of trembling, has been in Jewish hands for the past 50 years and we want to celebrate this historic and prophetic event during this year's Passover!
