

What is Passover?

Pesach (Passover) is one of the oldest Festivals celebrated in the world today, commemorating God's deliverance of the Jewish people from Egyptian bondage 3,500 years ago. Pesach is one of the most important of all the Seven Biblical Feasts. So important, that God in His recognition of Israel's deliverance from Egypt, chose to recognize it as the beginning of months and the anniversary of our freedom after 400 years of slavery. "This month shall be your beginning of months. It shall be the first month of the year to you." (Ex. 12:1,17) "Therefore you shall observe this day throughout your generations as an everlasting ordinance. The story of Passover is one of the greatest and mightiest acts that any generation has ever witnessed. (Deut. 4:32- 39). No other generation has ever witnessed the awesome power of Adonai. God chose the appointed Feasts as a way to remind us of His greatness, so that we might know, believe and proclaim that He alone is God and there is none else! Pesach is a seven-day Feast that begins on the 14th of Nisan. The eve of Pesach is observed with a special time called a SEDER, during which time the HAGGADA, a narrative describing the Exodus from Egypt, is read. We partake in ceremonial foods to remind us of the retelling of the Passover story.

Why do we celebrate?

As a Messianic Community, we observe Passover not only historically, as we are reminded of our deliverance from Egypt, but we also observe its Messianic fulfillment. Israel's Passover foreshadowed and pointed ahead 2,000 years to the time when the Messiah would come and bring the total and complete meaning of this feast to fulfillment.

As we celebrate this amazing Feast it will be a special year for Beth Shechinah. We will be celebrating our 30th. year anniversary as Calgary's First Messianic Congregation.

You are invited to celebrate this time with us on April 28th. 4pm. at the Carriage House.

This will also be a unique opportunity for the Messianic and Christian community to come together to show our love and support for Israel as she fights for her survival. There are global anti-Israel and anti-Semitic protests that have not abated. If ever there is a time to stand with Israel, now is the appointed time.
